1. PARTNERS: We are grateful for the intercessory ministry and donations of partners. Pray for the Holy Spirit's continuous presence with our partners - to help them accomplish what has been assigned to them by the Lord.

2. CEG MARKETING: There will be Christian literature sales at the Pastors and Church Leaders Conference in Accra, Kumasi, Takoradi, Ho, Sefwi-Wiawso and Tamale in the month of September. Pray for good patronage.

3. 2018 CEG NATIONAL PASTORS & CHRISTIAN LEADERS CONFERENCES: The Accra Conference begins today and ends on Thursday. The theme is "Family Life at the Cross Roads; what Choices?" Pray for smooth registration and awareness of God's presence. Pray the objectives of the conference will be achieved.

4. PRISON MINISTRY: Praise God for some local partners for the prison ministry and pray that more local sponsors will come forward.

5. CINEMA TODAY: Cinevan partnered the Tarkwa Assemblies of God Church for an evangelism outreach at Brofoyedin, a suburb of Tarkwa in the Western Region, in July 2018. An estimated audience of 2,500 attended. Those who stayed for counselling numbered 235. Praise! Please pray for the church as they follow-up with the new converts.

6. 2018 CEG NATIONAL PASTORS & CHRISTIAN LEADERS CONFERENCES: The Conference in Accra ends today. Pray participants will put more effort into deliberately making choices that positively impact their families and bring honour to God.

7. CEG STAFF: Pray the love of God will motivate our staff to give their best. Pray the Holy Spirit will empower us in doing our work with integrity.

8. CEG FINANCES: Pray for improved cash flow from literature sales to meet our financial obligations on schedule.

9. CINEMA TODAY: Aboso is a new and growing town in the Western Region where in July 2018 Cinevan, in partnership with the local Presbyterian Church of Ghana, held a gospel outreach. Out of the approximately 3,200 people in attendance 268 prayed to receive Christ as Saviour. Praise! Pray for effective Christian nurture by the Outreach Team of the local church.

10. 2018 CEG NATIONAL PASTORS & CHRISTIAN LEADERS CONFERENCES: The Kumasi Conference commences today. Pray attendance will increase from last year's numbers. Pray lives and ministries of participants will be positively impacted.

11. PRISON MINISTRY: Sydney Tamakloe served over 20 years in the Nsawam Medium Security Prisons where he found the Lord through CEG prison ministry. He needs support to start his tailoring shop. He learned to sew and was sewing officers' uniforms and clothes in the prison. He needs a foot pedal sewing machine and a knitting machine. Pray with us as we seek to help him start up his business.

12. CEG WAREHOUSE: Pray for accuracy, wisdom and strength for the warehouse staff as they receive and process stock for the peak sales season.

13. 2018 CEG NATIONAL PASTORS & CHRISTIAN LEADERS CONFERENCES: The Kumasi Conference ends today. Pray the conference will impact local churches and pastors as they focus on their families. Pray for safe travel as participants, speakers and organizers return home.

14. HOSPITAL MINISTRY: The 37 Military Hospital childrens' ward is a referral centre with critical cases on admission. These children have huge medical bills. Praise God for some funds made available by a kind donor to help defray patient costs. Pray for more support to help with the dire financial need of the families of so many of the patients.

15. CINEMA TODAY: In June 2017, Cinevan in collaboration with the local Methodist Church, held a gospel film show outreach at Nyanyano in the Central Region. About 2,500 people watched the films with 261 accepting Jesus as Saviour. Pray the local church will be effective with its follow-up and discipleship programs.

16. CEG MARKETING: Pray for quick and safe arrival of our major orders which should arrive before the end of October 2018.

17. 2018 CEG NATIONAL PASTORS & CHRISTIAN LEADERS CONFERENCES: The Takoradi Conference begins today. Pray for speakers and participants - that God's presence will guide and lead them. Pray that the presentations will encourage participation.

18. PRISON MINISTRY: Michael Ofose Frimpong served six years in the Winneba Local Prison for possessing and using Indian hemp. He testifies "I got salvation in Christ by the Challenge Prison Ministry Team through the Bible lessons they taught us..." Praise! Pray for a restored relationship for Michael with his father - who is still angry with his son who was a student at Winneba Senior High when he got himself in this mess.

19. CEG MARKETING: Pray our intensified outdoor sales will draw awareness to the reading of sound Christian literature – and also to the various ministries of CEG.

20. 2018 CEG NATIONAL PASTORS & CHRISTIAN LEADERS CONFERENCES: The Takoradi conference ends today. Pray that the lessons learned will be put into practice and the books bought will be read.

21. HOSPITAL MINISTRY: Let's pray that our support to help pay some bills for the children on admission at 37 Military Hospital will open the hearts of parents and children to the Lord Jesus Christ.

22. CINEMA TODAY: In conjunction with Cinevan, the local branch of the Church of Pentecost at Kakraba in the Central Region showed gospel films in June 2018. At the end of the programme, 128 out of an audience of approximately 1,600 people prayed to receive Christ. Praise! Pray these new converts will be established in the faith.

24. 2018 CEG NATIONAL PASTORS & CHRISTIAN LEADERS CONFERENCES: The Ho Conference starts today. Pray for travelling mercies for participants and speakers. Pray there will be good conference patronage and purchase of book sets.

25. EVANGELICAL MISSIONARY ALLIANCE (EMA): Pray for improvement in the finances of EMA as it needs funds to support mission outreach.

26. MARANATHA UNIVERSITY COLLEGE (MUC): Pray for God's provision and leading for the lecturers and administrative staff - and that books purchased will be read.

30. CINEVAN TOWN SPONSORS: Pray for donors to sponsor the operations of our fleet of three Cinevans which are twelve, nine and five years old respectively. It costs \$150.00 (or £115.00) for a Cinevan to visit a town or village at any given time to share the gospel, placing Bibles and Christian books in the hands of people living in these remote communities who do not have access to a Christian Bookshop. Pray with us for resources as we seek to replace the current ageing fleet of three and increase the total fleet to five vehicles.
