

Praise and Prayer Bulletin DECEMBER 2018



1. PRAYER PARTNERS & DONORS: We are grateful to the Lord for His constant faithfulness in the work He has called us into. Pray for God's grace and continued blessings on the lives of our dedicated prayer partners and donors.

2. CINEMA TODAY: Pray for the wives of the Cinevan staff as they parent single-handedly when their husbands are away. Pray for quality times with spouses and children when back home from the field. Pray these children will grow up in the knowledge and fear of God.

3. PRISON MINISTRY: Praise and thank God for His goodness in providing safe travels for prison chaplains throughout the year. Thank God for the shared partnership CEG has with others who visit prisons across the country.

4. CEG STAFF: Daniel Oppong and Kennedy Amoah, CEG drivers, will be extremely busy conveying supplies from the warehouse to our sales outlets during the peak sales season of December and January. Pray for good health, good judgement and God's protection as they make these travels.

5. CEG WAREHOUSE: Continue to pray for the warehouse staff to realize their work in the warehouse - receiving, managing and dispatching stock to several outlets - as critical to CEG's fulfillment of its overall purpose. They also need a deep sense of compassion as they bring their competence to bear on the work they do.

6. CEG FINANCES: Pray CEG can generate sales revenue to meet payment schedules on time - and also to have sufficient left to sustain its ministry costs.

7. CEG MARKETING: This Christmas season pray Christians will buy Bibles and other Christian literature to give out as gifts to draw unbelieving family members and friends to the Lord.

8. CINEMA TODAY: In September 2018 The Life International Church at Tema Community 5 partnered with Cinevan to show gospel films in the community. About 800 people were in attendance with 35 praying to receive Christ. Please pray for effective follow-up for these new believers.

9. CEG STAFF: Pray staff and their families will develop intimate relationships with the Lord. Pray that they will seek God's kingdom first - in confidence of His promises of sufficient provision and blessing on their lives.

10. PRISON MINISTRY: Praise and thank God for the special sponsorship - both local and foreign - that has helped CEG to visit prisons and provide supplies of food, medication, and some financial support for transport home after discharge from prison.

11. CEG MARKETING: Pray for God's guidance to adopt effective strategies to overcome the nuisance posed by pirated products.

12. CEG BOOKSHOPS: Pray all sales staff will be sensitive to customer needs - especially during the Christmas and New Year seasons when our shops are filled with customers.

13. HOSPITAL MINISTRY: Pray for sponsorship for CEG as it hopes to provide some Christmas items for the children at 37 Military Hospital where CEG chaplains visit.

14. CINEMA TODAY: Taifa is a suburb of Accra where, in September 2018, Cinevan with the local branch of the Presbyterian Church of Ghana, had a gospel outreach. After the altar call 251 prayed to receive Christ out of an estimated audience of 2,500. Pray for effective Christian nurture.

15. CEG FINANCES: We are trusting God that increased sales during the peak sales season - and both local and foreign donations - will improve CEG finances and enable ministry costs to be met effectively. Pray with us.

16. HOSPITAL MINISTRY: Praise God for sponsorship for some hospital medical bills and other supplies.

17. SIM: Pray for God's protection and direction for SIM missionaries working in Ghana - and Africa in general.

18. GHANA: Ghanaian roads are very busy during the Christmas and New Year seasons. Pray drivers will be careful, avoid over speeding and obey road traffic regulations in order to minimize road accidents.

19. PRISON MINISTRY: Many inmates have been in incarceration for years - some for forty or more years. Pray for pardon and amnesty for these inmates who are genuinely transformed and will be useful to society if discharged.

20. CINEMA TODAY: In September 2018, Cinevan collaborated with the local branch of the Assemblies of God Church in Tarkwa to reach out to the people of Tanoso in the Western Region. An estimated audience of 2,600 was in attendance with 180 praying to accept Christ as Lord and Saviour. Praise! Pray for the church as they follow up with new converts.

21. EVANGELICAL MISSIONARY ALLIANCE

(EMA): Pray for God's guidance and provision for the EMA Board and missionaries.

22. CEG SECURITY: Praise God for His protection of CEG staff and properties. Pray for strength, wisdom, protection and alertness for the security staff.

23. PRISON MINISTRY: Pray this Christmas season many prison inmates will experience the comfort, joy and peace which Christ offers.

24. MARANATHA UNIVERSITY COLLEGE (MUC): Pray for lecturers to readily give their all as they equip and prepare students for their various ministries. Pray for MUC leadership and administration.

25. CHRISTMAS DAY: Churches in Ghana will be filled to capacity today. Pray sermons preached will impact and transform lives for Christ and that many will make the decision to accept Christ as Lord and Saviour. Pray also that the essence of the season will be celebrated.

26. CEG STAFF: Praise God for blessing Ruth Dibert, Stella Grant, Rebecca Aryee and Sampson Appoh, all CEG staff, with babies in the month of September and October. Pray for God's protection and provision for the babies and their families.

27. CINEMA TODAY: Kwesimintsim is a densely populated suburb in the Takoradi area. In September 2018 the local branch of the Presbyterian Church, in cooperation with Cinevan, held a gospel outreach in the community. An audience of nearly 6,500 watched the films. Out of these, 222 prayed to receive Christ. Pray for effective discipling.

28. PRISON MINISTRY: There are many old and sick people who have been languishing in our prisons for many years. It's even reported that the longest serving prison inmate in the world is in the Nsawam Medium Security Prison and has been there for 47 years. Pray for divine intervention as these inmates need presidential pardon and amnesty.

29. GOSPEL TRACTS DISTRIBUTION: Pray for God's abundant provision of resources and dedicated staff for the World Missionary Press (USA), Eagle Nest (USA) and Revival Movement Association (UK) who supply CEG with gospel tracts for distribution.

30. PRISON MINISTRY: We have applied to the Ghana Prison Service Headquarters for the 2019 visitation permits to enable the chaplains to reach out to prison inmates. Pray they will be approved and permits granted quickly.

31. CINEVAN TOWN SPONSORS: Pray for donors to sponsor the operations of our fleet of three Cinevans which are 12, 9 and 5 years old respectively. It costs \$150.00 (or £115.00) for a Cinevan to visit a town or village at any given time to share the gospel, placing Bibles and Christian books in the hands of people living in these remote communities who do not have access to a Christian Bookshop. Pray with us for resources as we seek to replace the current ageing fleet of 3 and increase the total fleet to 5.
