1. GIVE THANKS FOR CEG PARTNERS & DONORS.

May they be richly rewarded for the sacrifices made in support of CEG. Pray the Lord will continue to bless and sustain them.

2. RAINY SEASON: The rains are heaviest in June and July. Pray for safe driving for CEG drivers, Daniel Oppong and Kennedy Amoah, as they convey merchandise from the CEG warehouse to the shops. Pray for fair evening weather in June as Cinevan staff show films across the country. Pray for Chaplains who also drive much to minister in the prisons.

3. CINEMA TODAY: In March Cinevan, in collaboration with the local branch of the Victory Bible Church International, organized an outreach programme at Ashaley-Botwe, a suburb of Accra. There was a total audience of about 2,600 with 122 praying to receive Christ. Pray for effective follow-up by the counseling team of the church.

4. CEG BOARD OF TRUSTEES: Praise God for members of the Board of Trustees who give freely of their time in the governance of CEG. Give thanks for the May 7th Board meeting. Pray for good health and God's wisdom for each member. Remember their families who support them.

5. CEG FINANCES: Pray for increased revenue from literature sales and fundraising efforts to finance CEG's Christian outreach ministries.

6. PRISON MINISTRY: Ogundele Ademola is a young man of 21 years who served a 6-month sentence for stealing a phone. He is now discharged and testifies that "Challenge has really helped me to know about myself and more about

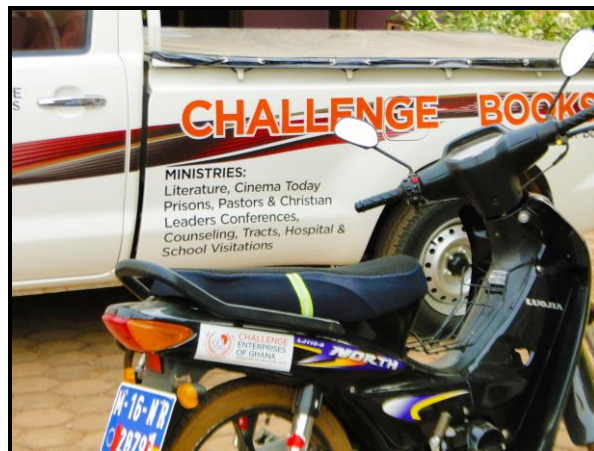
Christ and the Word of God". Pray for him to hold unto the faith and avoid bad company.

7. CEG NATIONAL PASTORS' & CHRISTIAN LEADERS' CONFERENCES: CEG is hoping for a total of 1,200 participants for the conferences in Accra, Kumasi, Takoradi, Ho, Sefwi-Wiawso, Sunyani and Tamale. Please join CEG in praying that this target will be achieved.

8. CINEMA TODAY: In March 2019 Cinevan partnered with the local Presbyterian Church for a gospel film outreach at Kwesimintsim in the Western Region. The showing attracted an estimated audience of 7,500 with 280 praying to receive Christ. Among them was a young Muslim. Pray the church can effectively disciple the new converts. Pray especially for the Muslim convert to be rooted in faith.

9. MARANATHA UNIVERSITY COLLEGE (MUC): Pray MUC is able to meet all the requirements of the national accreditation Board so its status as an educational institution can be reinstated.

10 CEG STAFF: Pray CEG Staff and their families will value the *Call* and the *Competence* required for service at CEG. Pray all staff will submit to God and have an intimate walk with Him. Pray for good health and protection.

11. PRISON MINISTRY: CEG Prison Ministry needs more resources to keep providing essential medication for inmates, food supplies, transport fares for discharged inmates, Bibles and Devotionals. Pray for effective partnerships - and that the Lord of the harvest will provide. Pray that the Prison car will serve its purpose. Give thanks - and pray for local donors who give to the prison ministry.

12. CINEMA TODAY: Akyempim is a mining town in the Western Region and in March 2019, Cinevan partnered with the local Assemblies of God Church for a gospel film outreach. An estimated audience of 5,000 watched the films that night. When the altar call was made, a total of 226 came forward to accept Jesus Christ as Saviour. The following Sunday, 37 of the new converts joined the Church. Praise! Pray the new converts will be grounded in the faith.

13. SIM: Pray for friends who are willing to listen to the gospel - that God will touch their hearts. (TIJIN & MERIN)

14. EVANGELICAL MISSIONARY ALLIANCE (EMA): Pray for improvement in the finances of EMA.

15. PRISON MINISTRY: Castello is a Venezuelan national who found Christ while serving his sentence at the Nsawam Medium Security Prison in Ghana. He is excited with his faith and wants to carry an English Bible back to his country. Pray he will be a testimony to his family.

16. CEG PASTORS & CHRISTIAN LEADERS CONFERENCES: Any instability of the local currency against the US Dollar impacts CEG's ability to make the pricing of the pastors' book set affordable. (CEG has historically subsidized these book sets.) Pray for the needed resources to meet this critical need in Ghana.

17. CEG MULTI-STORY BUILDING PROJECT: Pray for a focused vision for this project that has been approved by the CEG Board of Trustees. Pray God will lead CEG to seek Joint Venture partners of integrity, both within and outside of Ghana, in realizing this project in a mutually beneficial way.

18. GOOD NEWS BIBLE CHURCH: Pray for the Holy Spirit's guidance for Church leadership in the important decisions they make.

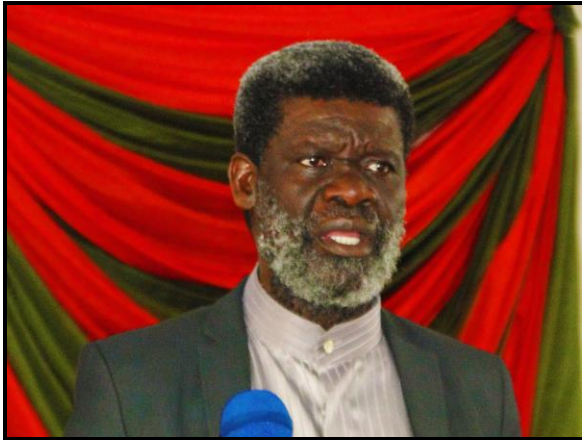
19. CEG ANNUAL PASTORS' & CHRISTIAN LEADERS' CONFERENCES: The second and final invitation letter has been mailed. Pray churches and individuals will prioritize funds for registration and purchase of book sets. Pray for excellent participation.

20. CINEMA TODAY: In March Cinevan partnered with a local branch of The Church of Pentecost for a programme in Tarkwa in the Western Region. About 2,500 people watched the films. Some 225 people stepped forward to accept Christ after the altar call. Praise! Pray for effective discipling of the new believers by the local Church.

21. PRISON MINISTRY: There are a couple of volunteers partnering with CEG Prison Ministry to visit, preach, teach, disciple and counsel inmates. Praise! Pray these volunteers will be blessed by the Lord with resources to meet the needs of inmates.

22. CEG BOOKSHOPS: Pray for increased sales in the 12 bookshops and other sales outlets across the country. Pray Bibles, books and other items sold will bring many blessings to customers.

23. SPIRITUAL LIFE CONFERENCE: CEG Senior Team and staff will hold this year's Spiritual Life Conference from July 5-7, 2019. The theme is "A Transformed Life". The main Speaker is Apostle Jude Hama, a member of the CEG Board of Trustees. Pray CEG's Senior team and staff will work together well in their bid to transform lives through the spoken and written Word of God. Pray also for individual life transformation for all.

24. CINEMA TODAY: In March 2019, Cinevan with the local branch of the Methodist Church Ghana, held an outreach ministry in Morree, a fishing town in the Central Region. About 2,000 people were present for the programme. When the altar call was made, 325 remained for counselling. Pray for effective Christian nurture.

25. PRAY FOR THE MILLIONS OF CHRISTIANS SUFFERING PERSECUTION in countries where the Christian faith is in the minority. Ask God to strengthen and sustain them.

26. CINEMA TODAY: Kasoa Kalabule is a suburb of Kasoa in the Central Region. In March 2019, Cinevan visited the community for a gospel outreach activity. About 1,200 people were present to watch the film shows with 151 of them praying to receive Christ. Praise! Pray the converts will be established in the faith.

27. PRAY FOR ADEQUATE FINANCIAL RESOURCES for CEG's overseas partners who ship gospel tracts and scripture booklets for distribution, namely: World Missionary Press, Inc. USA; Eagle Nest (Love Packages) USA; and Revival Movement, (N. Ireland, UK).

28. PRAY FOR NEW WORLD MISSIONARY PRESS BOOKLET *Who do you say that I Am?* Pray that this tool will be used by God to draw many to Jesus. Pray also for guidance as to language translations for these booklets.

29. TRACTS DISTRIBUTION: Many churches, itinerant evangelists and individuals collect tracts and other literature received from World Missionary Press and Eagles Nest, USA and Revival Movement (UK) for distribution. Pray the Holy Spirit will use these tracts to lead many to Salvation.

30. CINEVAN TOWN SPONSORS: Pray for donors to sponsor the operation of CEG's fleet of three Cinevans which are 13, 10 and 7 years old respectively. It now costs **\$200.00** or **£120.00** for a Cinevan to visit a town or village at any given time to share the gospel, placing Bibles and Christian books in the hands of people living in these remote communities who do not have access to a Christian Bookshop.

Give thanks to God for a new replacement Cinevan built in Dubai and made available through a generous donor. Pray for its safe arrival soon in the port of Tema after being shipped earlier in the month. CEG continues to trust God for further funds to purchase two additional Cinevans.
