I'm writing you today with an urgent prayer request concerning the son of one of my English students from China, Emily.



I am writing you this morning with an urgent prayer request. Feng Tian, the son of one of my English students from China, Emily, disappeared in Montreal on Monday, October 17th, 2022, over a week ago now.

Feng Tian speaks Chinese, no French, and very little English!

Feng had just come from China to Montreal around the beginning of September, and had no desire to leave home. He was living with family in NDG and working on learning English at home, aided by his mother. He would have no idea of where to go, how to get around, or who to go to see.

Last evening, Emily called and told me that the police refuse to send out an amber alert for Teng as a missing person because they have no proof to know that he has been kidnapped. Given the exceptional nature of this case, I find this decision unkind and unfair. .

May our dear heavenly Father and His Son, our Saviour, hear from heaven and by the power of the Holy Spirit bring Feng home safe and sound very soon. If he is being retained somewhere, may God help him to escape. May Emily and the family also be drawn near to our loving Lord through this terrible state of suspense and anguish.

Thank you for your prayers, and any messages to Emily can be sent to me. Below please find the article written last Wednesday about Feng's disappearance.

Montreal police are asking for the public's help in finding a missing 17-year-old boy.

Tian Feng was last seen on Monday near the corner of Sherbrooke Street West and Cavendish Boulevard in the Côte-des-Neiges-Notre-Dame-de-Grâce borough.

Police say he is new to the country and does not speak English or French. Investigators and his family have reason to fear for his safety. Feng is 1.8 metres (5'11") tall, weighs 68 kilograms (150 lbs), has black hair and black eyes.

He was last seen wearing a black denim coat, a black sweater and black and white sneakers. Anyone with information regarding this disappearance is asked to call 911 or visit their local police station.
