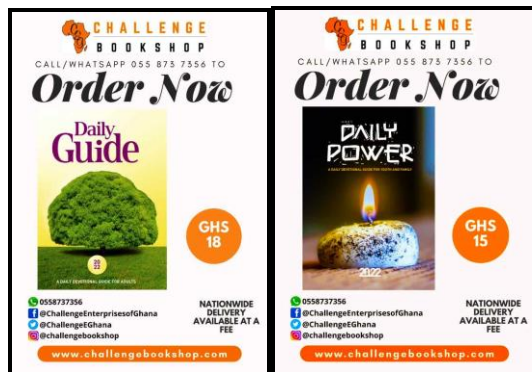

**2. CEG MARKETING:** Praise the Lord for the timely and safe arrival of some of the Scripture Union devotionals. Pray lives will be transformed through their use. Pray also for good sales.

**3. CEG FINANCES:** Pray with CEG's senior team for God's wisdom for prudent financial management in this challenging pandemic era.

**4. CEG WAREHOUSE:** Pray for strength and accuracy as the warehouse staff issue merchandise to CEG shops to meet increased demands during the Christmas and New Year season.

**5. SCHOOL MINISTRY:** Blue Crest University College is a new hands-on tertiary institution that has been opened very close to CEG. Pray for fruitful partnership as CEG seeks to help supply free Bible study materials and books for their library and explore how CEG can meet their textbook, books and stationery needs. Pray both faculty and students are reached for Christ.

**6. PRISON MINISTRY:** There have been no further teaching visits to prisons due to COVID-19 restrictions. However, give praise that special visits to James Camp Senior Correctional Centre (formerly Borstal Institute for Juveniles), Nsawam and Akuse prisons were made to deliver devotionals, Bible study materials, and both medical and food supplies. Pray 2022 will see all the prisons opened to enable full ministry to resume. Pray for quick renewal of CEG's prison permits.

**7. CEG MARKETING:** Pray the Lord will draw customers into CEG's retail and online shops during the Christmas and New Year season as they are engaged through various media. Pray CEG will be intentional in its marketing, planning and execution.

**8. PRISON MINISTRY:** Give thanks to God that the Prison Chaplain has remained safe as he travelled in his ministry vehicle across the few prison facilities he was granted special permission to make deliveries to. Pray for continued future protection.

**9. CEG MARKETING:** Pray customers will purchase Bibles and other Christian literature to use as gifts that will be instrumental in drawing unbelieving family members and friends to the Lord.

**10. PRISON MINISTRY:** COVID-19 restrictions brought to the fore the dire need for the supply of Emmaus Bible Correspondence Courses to the prisons. CEG has received sponsorship for 500 course sets. Give praise to God for this provision - although a 'drop in the ocean' compared to the need. Pray for additional sponsorship for more courses. Pray also that, as the inmates enroll for the course, they will encounter Christ and grow in His grace and knowledge.

**11. CEG BOOKSHOPS:** During the Christmas and New Year festivities CEG bookshops are busy. Pray for excellent customer care by shop staff despite the pressure.

**12. SIM:** Pray for the Lord's protection and cover for all SIM staff in Ghana in the coming year. Pray all SIM projects and equipment will function well.

**13. CEG STAFF:** Pray for safety and protection for CEG drivers; Daniel Oppong and Ken Amoah, as they transport goods from the warehouse to the shops throughout Ghana during this season.

**14. CEG MARKETING:** CEG sells over six varieties of daily devotionals in its shops. Pray for good patronage during this Christmas and New Year season. Continue to pray, also, that those who buy or receive these devotionals will use them regularly and find them helpful in their walk with the Lord.

**15. CINEMA TODAY:** CEG's fleet of vans continues to distribute Gospel tracts in numerous communities during the daylight hours. Pray that many will encounter the Lord Jesus Christ through these tracts.

**16. CEG NATIONAL PASTORS AND CHRISTIAN LEADERS CONFERENCES:** Thank God for a successful rescheduled conference in Ho which took place in November.

**17. CEG STAFF:** Pray for good health, wisdom, alertness, and God's protection over the lives of the security staff that guard CEG properties. Pray they will put their trust in the Lord always.

**18. GOSPEL TRACT DISTRIBUTION:** Pray for wise distribution of gospel materials and booklets from Revival Movement, UK. Pray these materials will be read and lives transformed.

**19. HOSPITAL MINISTRY:** Pray for a special touch of the Lord for children who are patients in the 37 Military Hospital. Pray also for peace and joy in this Christmas season for all medics, the children, their parents and care givers.

**20. CHALLENGE NATIONAL PASTORS AND CHRISTIAN LEADERS CONFERENCES:** Pray for the Sefwi-Wiawso, Sunyani and Tamale conferences that are scheduled in January and February 2022. Pray the conferences will be well attended. Pray also for funds to subsidize the registration fee for participants.

**21. EVANGELICAL MISSION ALLIANCE (EMA):** Pray for the Holy Spirit's leading for EMA's work. Pray for God's provision for logistics needed by the EMA.

**22. CEG STAFF:** Pray staff and the Senior Team will passionately own and build annual goals based on CEG's strategic plans for an effective and results-driven ministry to God's glory.

**23. CEG FINANCES:** Pray for business relations that are mutually beneficial to both CEG's local and international business partners in 2022. Pray also for sound financial management enabling CEG to meet the payment schedules of its suppliers.

**24. PRISON MINISTRY:** It's the season of Christmas - a time we celebrate the Incarnation of Christ who brought redemption, peace and joy to humankind. Pray inmates will especially experience the presence, peace and joy of Christ in this special season.

**26. MARANATHA UNIVERSITY COLLEGE (MUC):** Pray for the financial needs of the college - including the need for more classrooms to be built. Pray also for additional courses and qualified godly lecturers.

**27. CEG MULTI-STOREY BUILDING PROJECT:** Pray for a focused vision for this project that has been approved by the CEG Board of Trustees. Pray that God will lead CEG to seek Joint Venture partners of

integrity, both within and outside of Ghana, in realizing this project in a mutually beneficial way.

**28. GOSPEL TRACTS DISTRIBUTION:** Churches, itinerant evangelists and Christian fellowships collect tracts from CEG to distribute as they strive to share the message of God's salvation with others. Pray for the Holy Spirit's guidance in the distribution of tracts to the public.

**29. CINEVAN TOWN SPONSORS:** Pray for donors to sponsor the operations of CEG's fleet of three Cinevans. (Two Cinevans are 12 and 9 years old. The newest in the fleet is well over 2 years old.) It costs \$200.00 or £120.00 for a Cinevan to visit a town or village at any given time to share the gospel and place Bibles and Christian literature in the hands of people living in these remote communities who do not have access to a Christian Bookshop.

**30. CEG OUTREACH MINISTRIES:** Pray for more funding to enable CEG's ministries to reach more people with the message of God's love and salvation.

**31. PRAISE GOD FOR HIS FAITHFULNESS** in seeing all of us through this challenging year. Pray that He will strengthen us for all that 2022 will hold so that we will remain strong in faith and fruitful in the work of His kingdom
